### FROM THE COMMITTEE

You will notice our new red newsletter stationery today and we encourage you to support the eight businesses who continue to support us with advertising, several of them enduring for many years now. Their ongoing assistance is much appreciated.

In past years the P&C have offered a discount to stallholders for site fees with a yearly payment arrangement. However, due to recent wet weather and cancellations the 'free' month became difficult to administer, so for consistency, the Committee have decided to decline to continue with this offer in the future.

### F ROW TO GAZEBOS

Another reminder that sites F1 to 20 will be reconfigured to gazebo sites from November 2010. Last month one of the table tops actually collapsed; luckily it was empty but it is obvious that this is a potentially serious issue.

### TERMS & CONDITIONS

It is a big job to manage such a large market and apologies to those of you who do read this newsletter and abide by our Rules and Regulations, however it is always necessary to remind the small minority who 'forget' every month.

Sorry to repeat ourselves *again*, but we remind stallholders of the following abbreviated top 8 Terms and Conditions, which are consistently challenged:

**No. 1:** No vehicles are allowed to drive in or out of the market area between **7:30am** and **12:30pm**.....

**No. 5:** ...Stallholders must have the **correct site fee** available....  
No change will be carried by volunteers, nor will consideration be given for lack of sales.

**No. 7:** Permanent stallholders not attending a market **MUST** cancel their site **no later than 4pm Thursday** prior to that market .  
**No. 10:** **One way access** to the top of the market grounds for rows A, B, C, D and E, as well as the beginning of K, L and M rows (up to 10). Entry is at the top of the service station, and the exit via Short Street....

**No. 12:** Permanent or casually booked sites not occupied by **7am** will be **reallocated** to waiting traders.

**No. 13:** Stallholders are required to **keep their goods within** their allocated areas. Sandwich boards or display structures must not be placed in the walkways

**No. 14:** All stallholders selling food must **display** a current Food Licence from their City/Regional council, as well as the relevant Food Safety Supervisor details....

**No. 25:** All Stall Holders must comply with the price list below and complete a **Stallholder Registration Form** annually.

Your cooperation is appreciated. Should you require a copy of the Terms and Conditions, or a Registration form for 2010, please ask your Money Collectors, who will have copies on hand.
